After you write your words in bubble letters, color your words.</p>	<p>Perpendicular words Write each of your words across and down Ex: Cake a k e</p>
<p>Hangman Play hangman with at least 7 of your words with a parent or guardian. <u>Parent must sign paper!</u></p>	<p>Blue Vowels Write each of your spelling words. You will need a blue colored pencil. Trace over the vowels in each word with your blue pencil. Vowels: a,e,i,o,u</p>	<p>Other handed First write your spelling words the way you usually do, then try writing the list with your other hand.</p>	<p>Verbal Sentences Read each word aloud to your parent/guardian and use each one in a sentence verbally- you do not have to write it down. <u>Parent must sign paper!</u></p>
